Highlights

Court Jurisdiction and Proceedings Transfer Act — Section 4 — A defendant cannot avoid the provisions of ss. 3(d) and 8(a) of the Act by arguing that it no longer physically occupies its registered office. The obligation to maintain such an office rests with the partnership: *Mayer v. Merchant Law Group LLP*, 2023 BCSC 1797, 2023 CarswellBC 2996 (B.C. S.C.).

Enforcement of Canadian Judgments and Decrees Act — Section 5 — An Order of the Court of King's Bench of Alberta for the appointment of the guardianship of an adult may be registered under and is enforceable within British Columbia under the ECJDA: *M.F.G. v. K.J.M.*, 2023 BCSC 2322, 2023 CarswellBC 3907 (B.C. S.C.).
