

## PREFACE

These supplementary pamphlets contain forms for use in addition to those appearing in the bound volumes and also include comprehensive replacement sets of forms for revised UCC Article 3 (negotiable instruments), amended UCC Article 4 (bank deposits and collections), revised UCC Article 5 (letters of credit), and revised UCC Article 8 (investment securities). Also, forms are included for use under UCC Chapters 2A (leases of personal property) and 4A (funds transfers).

The Washington Legislature adopted Revised Article 9 in Chapter 250 of the 2000 legislative session, with a delayed effective date of July 2, 2001.

The forms and commentary for use under Article 2 on sale of goods have been extensively revised in this supplement for purposes of remaining current with commercial practices and reflecting new developments in the application of Article 2 to contracts for the sale of goods. Some updating of current Article 9 forms and commentary has been undertaken, as well.

Although every effort has been made to provide the Washington practitioner with the most current information and viable forms for use under the UCC, the publisher cannot guarantee the currency of these materials. Those advising clients must, as always, conduct thorough research into the state of the law before drafting forms for use in the commercial environment.
