Highlights

The 2025 update includes discussion of:

- **CHAPTER 1 (Branches of Government):** That an executive order devoted solely to the internal management of the executive branch that does not create any private rights is not subject to judicial review.
- **CHAPTER 20 (Federal Employees' Compensation Act):** The Department of Labor's Office of Workers' Compensation Program—Division of Federal Employees' Compensation release of a bulletin stating it will consider firefighters diagnosed with certain cancers not previously covered by separate legislation to be “high risk” and qualifying for an “expedited handling process.”
- **CHAPTER 36 (OSHA Enforcement):** OSHA’s revision of what has come to be known as the “Walkaround Rule,” which gives employees and employers the right to have a representative accompany OSHA Compliance Officers during physical inspections of worksites for the purpose of aiding such inspections.

- CHAPTER 51 (Federal Environmental Law): Ohio v. Env't Prot. Agency in which the Supreme Court held the Clean Air Act's (CAA) requirement, that a litigant may pursue in court only claims premised on objections first raised with reasonable specificity before the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) during the public comment period, does not call for a hair-splitting approach.
- CHAPTER 74 (Immigration and Naturalization): A new section addressing removal under Alien Enemies Act.
- CHAPTER 89 (Oversight): President Donald Trump's controversial removal of Susan Tsui Grundmann from the Federal Labor Relations Authority, which decision a court reversed by issuing a permanent injunction.
- CHAPTER 118 (Fiduciary Responsibility): That on April 25, 2024, the Department of Labor published Retirement Security Rule - Definition of an Investment Advice Fiduciary, effective September 23, 2024, which defines who is an investment advice fiduciary for purposes of (ERISA).
