He is the author of *LAW OF SENTENCING*, considered the national authority and cited more than 300 times in judicial opinions and law reviews.



At Harvard, Campbell was a rugby player and boxing champion. He now plays polo in Southern California, where he also sits on the board of directors for San Diego's Appellate Defenders, Inc., and Federal Defenders, Inc. Since 1976 he has taught full-time at California Western School of Law.
