

State PER Tab Contents

Tab I - How to Use: Contains an introduction to the PER series and an explanation of how to use the indexes and tables to streamline your research.

Tab II - Highlights: The Highlights provide a quick update of the most recent decisions and rulings in order to keep labor relations practitioners current on changes in the law.

Tab III - Statutes/Regulations: This section contains the entire text of the public sector collective bargaining statutes as well as the regulations of the labor relations agency for the specific state edition in the PER series. The statutes and regulations are supplemented as necessary to incorporate amendments.

Tab IV - Subject Index: A listing in alphabetical order of topical key words and terms used in public sector labor relations. Generally, the subscriber should begin her research with this index.

Tab V - Numerical Index: A comprehensive list of the index numbers used by the summaries.

Tab VI - Table of Cases: Lists in alphabetical order all of the reported administrative and judicial decisions in the state specific reporter. Each case is listed separately by case name, accompanied by an abbreviation to indicate the issuing authority, the docket or case number, the year in which the decision was rendered, and the citation to the PER. With regard to judicial decisions, note the case citation is listed under both parties names.

Tab VII - Statute/Regulation Tracker: Lists all significant administrative statutes and rules cited in decisions reported in that state edition of the PER. Citations in boldface type refer to the cited statute or regulation. Citations immediately following the cited statute/regulation refer to those decisions in which the cited statute/regulation appears.

Tab VIII - Topical Index/Digest: This section lists cases reported in the Current Reports Binder, alphabetically by topic, including brief summaries of the holdings and major legal principles discussed in each case. A Master List of Topical Headings precedes each summary to facilitate your search for topics relevant to you.

Tab IX - Citators: This table cross-references PER citations of judicial decisions to their parallel citations in the official court reporters, if available. Immediately following the Citator table is the Citation Tracker, which lists all significant administrative and judicial decisions cited in decisions reported in that state edition of the PER.

Tab X - Decisions: The full text of all cases reported within the current volume year are located in the Current Reports Binder. Cases from previous years are located in Transfer Binders.
