Although not a feature found in the majority of federal prosecutions, use of the grand jury's investigative authority continues to be ubiquitous in the federal system, particularly in the larger districts. Congress has largely left regulation of federal grand jury investigations to the federal judiciary (which has generally continued with the standards of common law) and to the internal regulations of the Department of Justice. As the grand jury is employed by these interested parties as both a "shield" against mistaken and vindictive prosecution and a "sword", combating crime in the use of its investigative power, sources of tension and annual developments abound. Hence the ongoing need for this authored analysis.
