

## PREFACE

This supplement brings Kansas Code of Civil Procedure, Annotated, Volumes 4–6, 5th Edition (2012) up to date as of April 30, 2025. This supplement integrates both statutory, case law, and supreme court rules changes into the text of the fifth edition. This supplement also includes analyses of the new provisions in K.S.A. Chapter 60, 60-5101–60-5108 (the Sharia law act) and 60-5201 (the transparency in lawsuits protection act), the many 2017 discovery amendments, the enactment of the *Daubert* standard under 60-456 for admission of expert witnesses, new peer-counselor privileges in 60-473, amended injunction rules, revamped non-economic damages caps in 60-19a02, the inclusion of filing fees for all dispositive motions, and much more. The many temporary 2020-2021 COVID-19 orders have not been included in this update as they are (we all hope) temporary and soon to expire. I have, however, included COVID-responsive statutory amendments even when coupled with sunset provisions, K.S.A. 60-5501 et seq.

The sad duty of informing you that Professor Casad passed in April 2023 falls to me. Professor Casad was an internationally renowned expert in procedure, a master teacher, and a wonderful person. His impact upon Kansas law lives on not only in this treatise, but in the lives of the thousands of attorneys he instructed.
