

PREFACE

Business Regulation in Minnesota attempts to compile all of the major business law-related state and federal statutes and regulations in one user-friendly publication.

As such, the State pamphlet includes statutes and regulations that address:

1. The regulation of securities and franchises;
2. The regulation of corporations and other business entities;
3. The regulation of trade and consumer protection;
4. The Uniform Commercial Code;
5. The regulation of property interests and liens;
6. The regulation of judicial procedure, pleadings, judgments, costs, etc.; and
7. The regulation of collection and compensatory remedies.

In like fashion, the Federal pamphlet addresses statutes and regulations that discuss:

1. Antitrust law;
2. Securities law;
3. Trademark law;
4. Copyright law;
5. Consumer credit protection;
6. Consumer product warranties;
7. Consumer fraud;
8. Internet law and e-commerce;
9. Electronic signatures;
10. Privacy;
11. Sarbanes-Oxley regulation;
12. Business crimes, including mail fraud and RICO;
13. The regulation of credit practices; and
14. CERCLA.

Because of space limitations, only the most frequently used materials are included. In addition, certain “specialized” areas (such as patent law and bankruptcy law) are intentionally omitted.
