

INTRODUCTION

This new volume is updated in 2025 to incorporate and report on recent developments affecting practice in the Minnesota appellate courts, including:

- Significant changes to Rule 112, governing non-public information and materials on appeal.
- The addition of Rule 126.03, a new rule which provides a mechanism for attorneys to obtain an automatic personal leave continuance of up to 90 days in specified circumstances, without disclosing private medical or personal details to the court or opposing counsel.
- Clarification that an amicus curiae brief may be filed only by an attorney admitted to practice before the appellate court.
