Information Security and Privacy: A Guide to International Law and Compliance is the first book to tackle the topic of information security and privacy in this comprehensive a manner. The legal landscape has changed dramatically in the last several years and news laws are added routinely. Few recent changes to privacy law have garnered as much attention as the EU General Data Protection Regulation, or GDPR. Since its enactment, large fines have been issued to companies that have been found to be not in compliance. One of the goals of GDPR is to attempt to harmonize some of the Member States' laws, and the GDPR accomplishes that goal, though Member States still have some room to make changes. In the wake of the GDPR, a number of states, including California, have passed comprehensive data privacy legislation. There are differences between these laws and the GDPR, with some provisions more specific and other areas where the GDPR goes beyond the new state laws. It is important for businesses to understand the new rules. Additionally, non-privacy and security-based laws can have an impact on cybersecurity, privacy, and other data issues.

Updates to the 2025-2026 edition includes updates to Chapter 2 (including the Cyber Resiliency and NIS2), extensive coverage of UK law, expanded coverage of Indian law, as well as of China's laws. As the law continues to evolve, the law in many other chapters will be updated in future editions.
