

Introduction to the 2025-2026 Edition

The 2025-2026 Edition of *Bad Faith Actions: Liability and Damages 2d* includes a complete update of existing sections. A few highlights are:

- A District Court of Appeal in Florida held that an insurer has no duty to enter into a consent judgment exceeding policy limits. § 3:40.
- The Supreme Court of Kentucky found that an insured's judgment creditors could bring a claim against liability insurer for bad faith and violation of Unfair Claims Settlement Practices Act before coverage was finally adjudicated. § 6:9.
- Court of Appeal in California held that absent an actual withholding of disability-insurance benefits, there was no breach of contract and no breach of the insurer's implied covenant of good faith and fair dealing. § 7:6.

This release is also updated with new Table of Contents, Table of Laws and Rules, Table of Cases, and Index to reflect these enhancements.
