

## **Preface to 2025-2026 Edition**

This year's volume of New Jersey Arrest, Search and Seizure Review has been reorganized to provide additional information to the user. The volume is now divided into two parts. Part I contains an analysis and general review of important 4th and 5th Amendment topics. A new section, Chapter 12, has been added to this year's volume relating to 5th Amendment issues that arise under *Miranda v.
