- Expanded section discussing how many life stories are protected via two contracts. One agreement being an option agreement allowing a producer to shop the life story and the second being a purchase of rights agreement for use by the purchaser to create the life story project. (see § 9:93)

- New section discussing concerns over abuses in creating intimate scenes addressed by the Producer-SAG-AFTRA Guild Codified Basic Agreement of 2023. The section also includes an intimate scene rider for performers hired to appear in nude scenes who are members of SAG-AFTRA. (see § 9:105)
- New chapter discussing artificial intelligence (AI), the use of AI in the creation of content, and the challenges of intellectual property protection of traditional and AI created content in the context of the entertainment industry. (see Chapter 24)
