

Preface

These volumes are meant to serve as a quick, comprehensive and easy guide to New Jersey insurance statutory law and will provide a convenient starting point for legal research related to a broad spectrum of insurance issues.

Although hundreds of statutory references to insurance law permeate the New Jersey statutes, as a practical matter, the main body of insurance law has been codified in Title 17, extending from N.J.S.A. 17:17-1 through 17B:35-7.

There are also numerous motor vehicle insurance statutes contained in Title 39. The annotations for these statutes are set forth in a separate Thomson-Reuters publication by this author, *New Jersey Motor Vehicle Code Annotated*.

New Jersey insurance law tends to be highly dynamic due to a large number of published opinions that annually come from the courts. There are also frequent statutory enactments and amendments by the legislature. As a result, these volumes are updated on a yearly basis.

Finally, the annotations are written in a manner that will stress recent developments in the law as opposed to obscure published decisions discussing repealed laws that have no further modern-day relevance apart from historical interest. For purposes of accuracy, whenever possible, the annotations in these volumes will use a direct quote from the opinion which references the statute under review with appropriate pin-point citation.
