

WHAT'S NEW IN THE NOVEMBER 2025 EDITION

New features and recent developments in this November 2025 Edition include:

- Enhanced coverage of location-tracking technologies, including the legality of geofence warrants and the use of cell tower dumps (Ch. 4).
- Expanded discussion of requirements for providers to preserve electronic communications or to withhold notice of law enforcement activities (Ch. 3).
- Expanded discussion of statutes of limitations and exhaustion of administrative remedies under the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act and the Stored Communications Act (Chs. 8, 9).
- Expanded discussion of the consent exception to interceptions under Title III, including the application of the carveout for criminal and tortious purpose with respect to entities that share personally identifiable customer data (Chs. 3, 8).
- New case law on application of the Stored Communications Act, including what constitutes an electronic communication service or remote computing service, a facility, the contents of a communication, and basic subscriber information (Chs. 3, 4).
