

## 2025-3 Highlights

If you are a subscriber to the set, please replace volume 3 with this revised volume. Note that the replaced pamphlet is a slightly larger size, but the remaining volumes in the set will be gradually replaced with this larger size. This softcover format improves the reader's experience in terms of filing pages within a limited binder system—allowing the work to easily expand as discussion of the law dictates. Though the format has changed, customers are not being charged more for this format change. Subscribers will pay the same overall price that they would have been charged during the course of the year.
