The text contains important trial motions for general use in many civil cases, as well as a number of helpful motions specifically for personal injury cases. While the publisher has attempted to include many essential motions, not every possible motion or motion issue can be covered in this text. We welcome your feedback or contributions regarding other possible motions, motion issues or any additional matter.

2. Quick-Research Format

CONNECTICUT MOTIONS IN LIMINE is organized in a unique “quick-research” format that allows you to zero in on key authorities and suggested motion text while in your office or in court. Other than the first chapter, which provides an overview of *in limine* law, every chapter contains the following quick-research format:

1. Suggested Motion Text
2. Motion Summary
3. Supporting Authorities
4. Opposition Authorities
5. Sample Motions

Note that this text contains a useful compendium of citations and samples on a number of commonly filed motions in limine. The publisher has attempted to include key citations to support each motion and provide a bouncing off point for further research. If you do not find support for your motion in this book, check other traditional Connecticut evidence resources. *Important:* Once you have found a helpful case, read it in full to be sure that the point is applicable to your facts and cite check it to ensure that it is still good law.
