

## 2025-4 Highlights

This release replaces volume 2 of *Transnational Contracts*. This practice-oriented manual assists attorneys in identifying and addressing issues arising in the planning and execution of international sales contracts. The author's insightful commentary covers both commercial and relevant regulatory issues.
