### Highlights

In this update to *Snows Criminal Code*, new cases are added on: rights to counsel before a strip search (*Thompson*, 2025 ONCA 500, 2025 CarswellOnt 11174 (Ont. C.A.), in Charter Alert and § 41:39); the power to arrest without a warrant (*Carignan*, 2025 SCC 43, 2025 CarswellQue 12684 (S.C.C.) in Charter Alert and § 41:53); particularization of the charge in child pornography cases (*J.J.K.G.*, 2025 BCCA 234, 2025 CarswellBC 2006 (B.C. C.A.) in § 7.59.1) and the availability of the writ of *habeus corpus* (*Dorsey & Salay*, 2025 SCC 38, 2025 CarswellOnt 18842 (S.C.C.) in § 37:5).
