

INDEX

The index references are to:

- section numbers of the commentary (Chapters 1 to 6);
- section numbers of the Workers Compensation Act (most refer to Part 2 – Occupational Health and Safety, with some referring to Part 1)
- section numbers of the Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Regulation
- section numbers of the OHS Citations Regulation

References to section numbers of the commentary are preceded by a lower case c, e.g., c1-1.0.

References to section numbers of the Workers Compensation Act are preceded by the acronym WCA.

References to section numbers of the OHS Regulation are preceded by the acronym OHSR.

References to section numbers of the OHS Citations Regulation are preceded by the acronym OHSCR.
