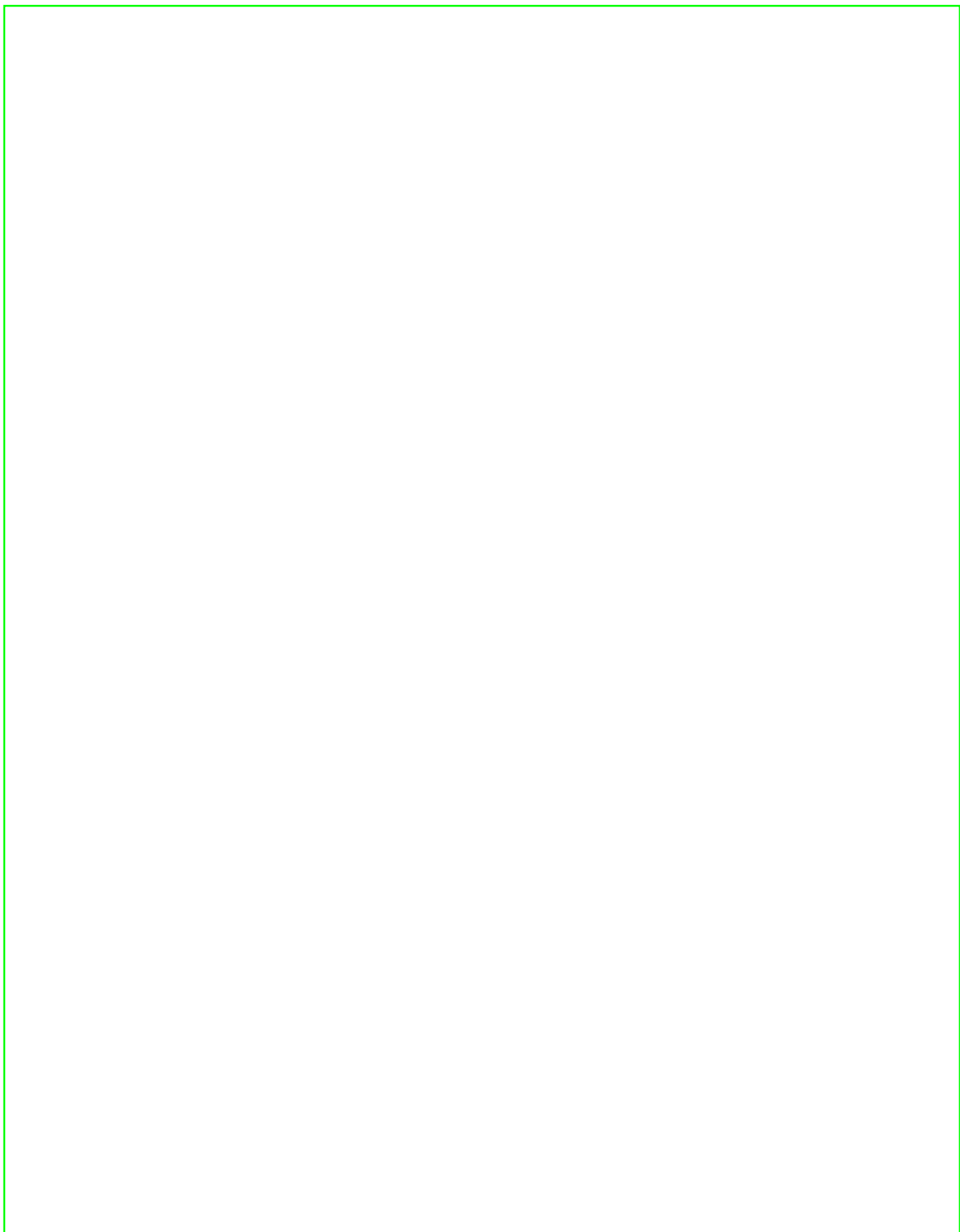
This edition contains new instructions and special verdict forms. It is the firm hope of the publisher and the committee that this updated edition will continue to be of assistance to the bench and bar.

BAJI FORMS has been compiled to be used in conjunction with California Jury Instructions—Civil (BAJI).

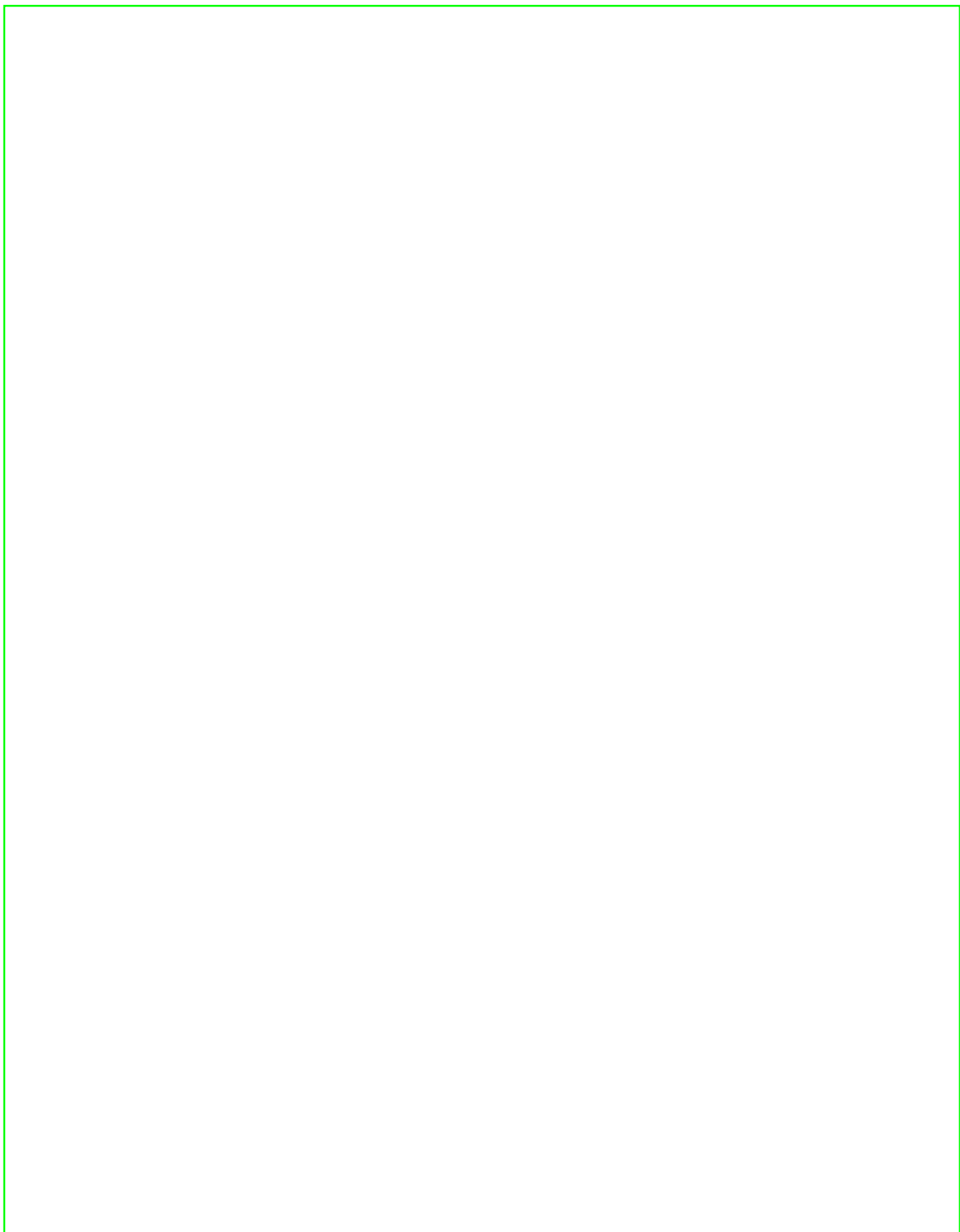
