The legislation entries in the index are referenced to the section numbers of specific Acts and Regulations. Where the references are to section numbers of Acts and Regulations, the following acronyms will appear before the section number:

PIPA(BC) = *Personal Information Protection Act* of British Columbia

BCPIPAR = B.C. Reg. 473/2003 — Personal Information Protection Act Regulations

PIPA(AB) = *Personal Information Act* of Alberta

ABPIPAR = Alta. Reg. 366/2003 — Personal Information Protection Act Regulations
